"We are more than food"

We believe passionately that emergency food is not the solution to food poverty. In 2018, we established Foodbank Plus, a service funded by Wirral Foodbank and delivered by Citizens Advice Wirral. Its purpose is to address and tackle the underlying reasons why people need to use foodbanks.

Foodbank Plus makes a real difference. In the past 12 months we have delivered over £260,000 in financial support, through new benefit entitlements, benefit backpay, debt write-off (through accessing local and national funds) and the provision of white goods, via local charities. Foodbank Plus has a dedicated team of three full-time advisors, based across our 11 centres, who provide in-person and telephone support.

Foodbank Plus is an essential support service, made possible through the generous support from donations received. Help us to continue this with this service.

Behind the numbers are individuals.

Let's hear from someone who was helped by Foodbank Plus and received "more than food."

Anna (*) attended Wirral Foodbank. In addition to requiring emergency food, she needed help in applying for Personal Independence Payment (PIP). Following a conversation with a volunteer she was referred to Foodbank Plus, who completed a PIP application. As part of an overall benefit check, an application was also made for Severe Disability Premium. Both applications were successful, resulting in an additional £150 per week, plus £3,380 in backdated benefit payments. Anna said that she was "over the moon" with the outcome, and thanked us for our help and advice, which had left her in a better financial situation, and feeling less anxious about the future.
