We continue to see growing demand for our services. In April, we provided 1,226 emergency food parcels – a 15% increase compared with the same month last year – including 370 parcels for children. Since September, we have provided a total of 9,645 emergency food parcels. Thank you for your continued support.

We provide more than food...

Through our initiative **Foodbank Plus**, delivered in conjunction with Citizens Advice Wirral, we are able to provide support that is more than just food parcels.

Recently, an individual attended our foodbank centre who was living in a property in disrepair and experiencing financial difficulties. They were also unsure what support was available to them. Foodbank Plus arranged an appointment with a caseworker to provide the individual with the support they needed. The individual said, "I am so glad that I came in today to speak with you." In April, Foodbank Plus supported 208 people and secured **£23,000*** in financial gains for those accessing the service.

**Financial gains do not necessarily relate to clients supported in the month; in many cases it can take up to 12 months for cases to be resolved.*
